Key Practices:

- Maintain a 1-foot minimum spacing when seated or standing

- Demonstrate neutral hand posture:
 - Men: relaxed or clasped hands
 - Women: folded hands or open palms
- Use visual demonstrations and role-play to reinforce

- Use clear, motive-driven language that reflects public approval
- Address challenges:
 - Musical/media influences on speech patterns

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Safe Distancing Practices

- [] Use neutral hand posture:
